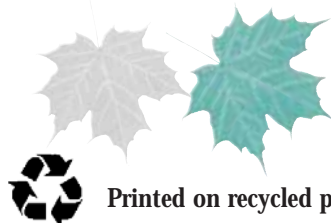

OESI

Ohio Environmental Service Industries (OESI) is a trade association of Ohio's commercial hazardous waste management facilities and associated businesses. Our members provide chemical recycling, treatment and disposal services. Our associate members provide services related to this industry.

OESI holds six meetings each year in Columbus or at a member facility to discuss legislative, regulatory and communication issues affecting the industry. We advocate before the state legislature and Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) regarding legislation or regulations pertinent to our member facilities.

- **OESI active members are commercial hazardous waste management facilities with RCRA permits. Together, they receive and process nearly 600,000 tons (that's 1.2 billion pounds) of hazardous waste each year, which represents 70% of the total hazardous waste commercially treated, recycled or disposed in Ohio.**
- **OESI associate members provide support services such as transportation, drum cleaning, environmental insurance, education, training, legal counsel, personal protective apparel, hazardous material equipment, risk communications and engineering services.**

- To provide a forum for our members to promote professional and environmentally sound hazardous materials management practices, including chemical recycling, treatment, storage and disposal for the protection of human health and the environment.
- To promote communication with the public regarding sound hazardous materials management practices.
